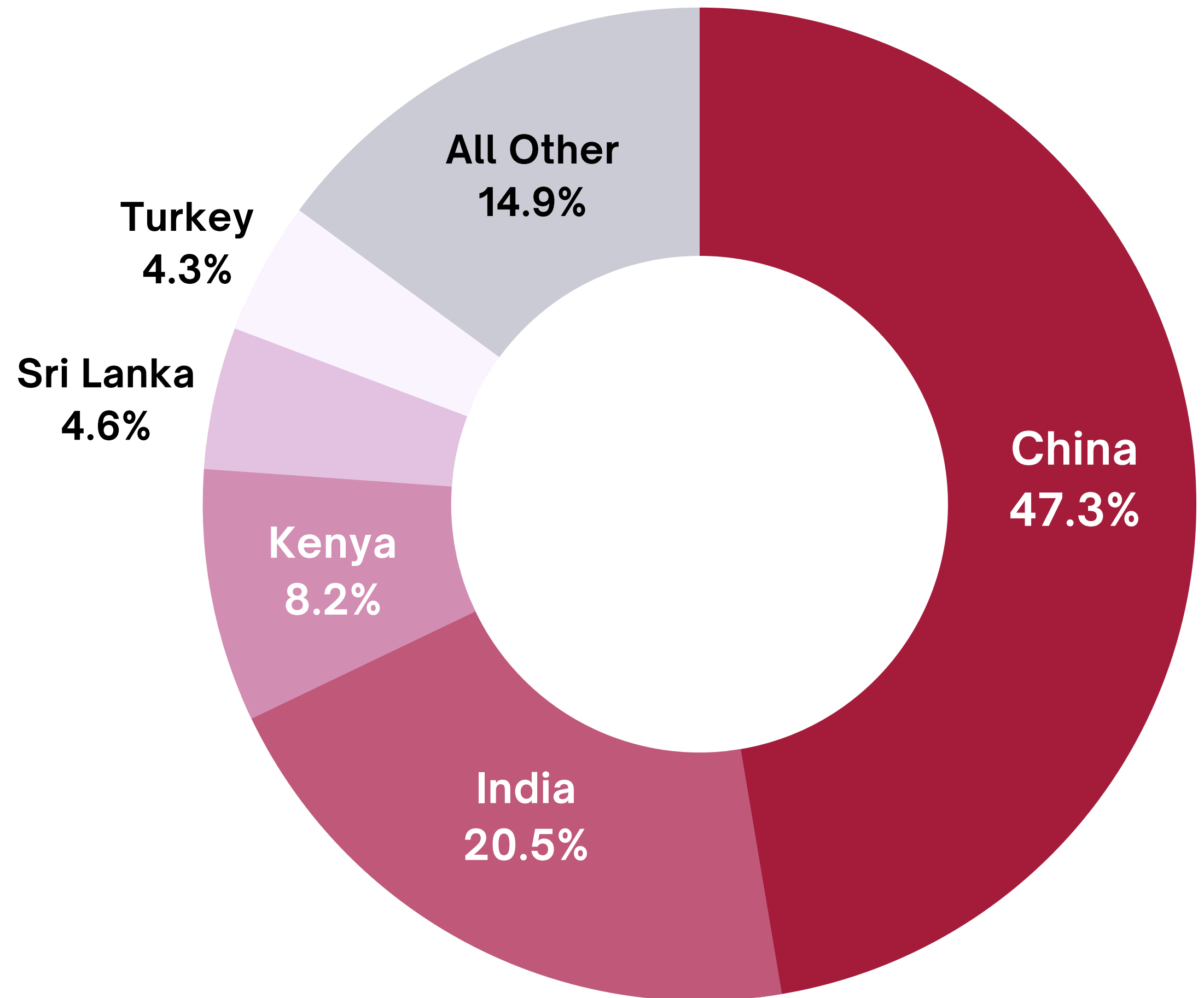


2021 Global Production

Up 37.3% over 2012



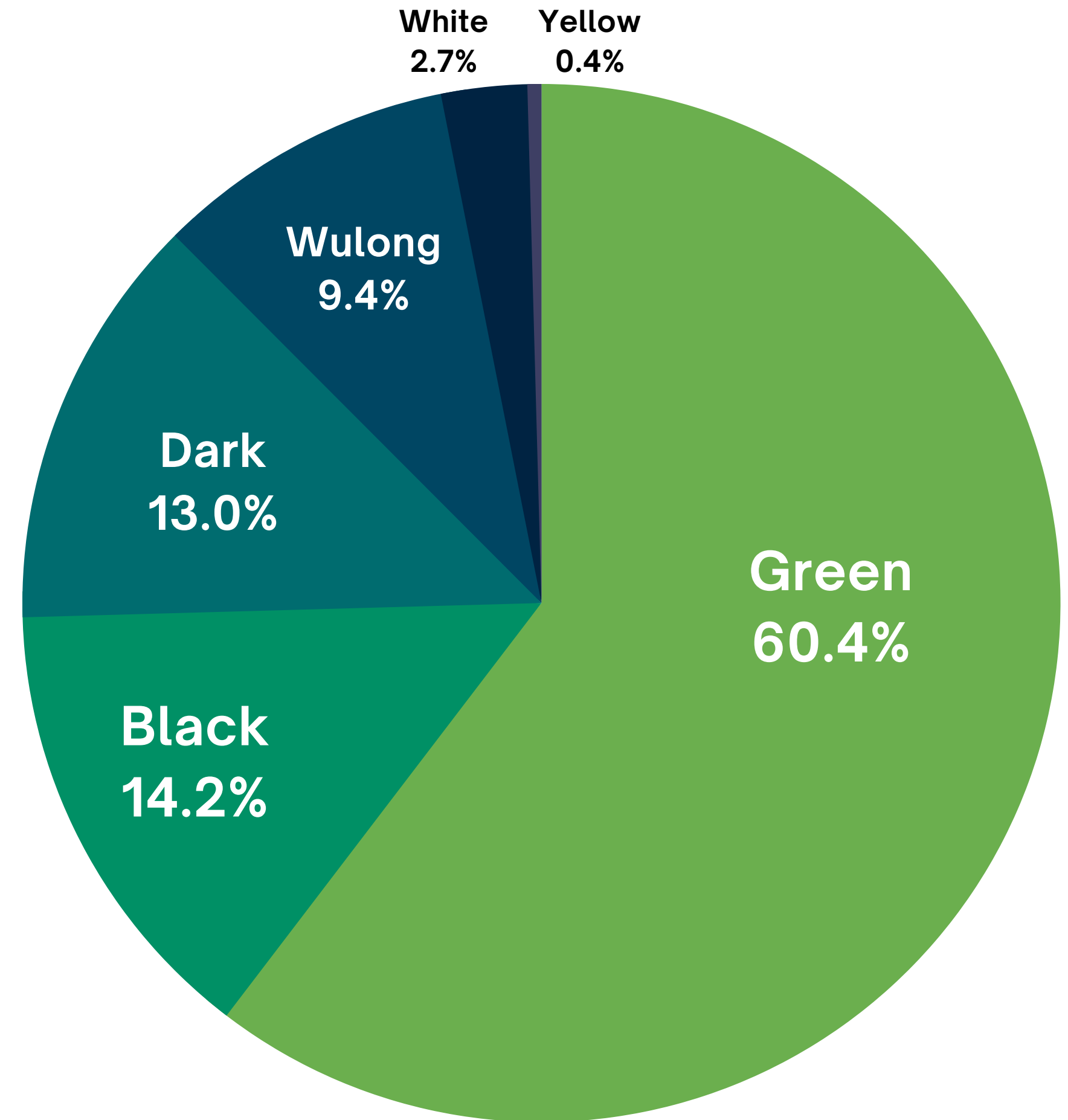

in Metric Tonnes

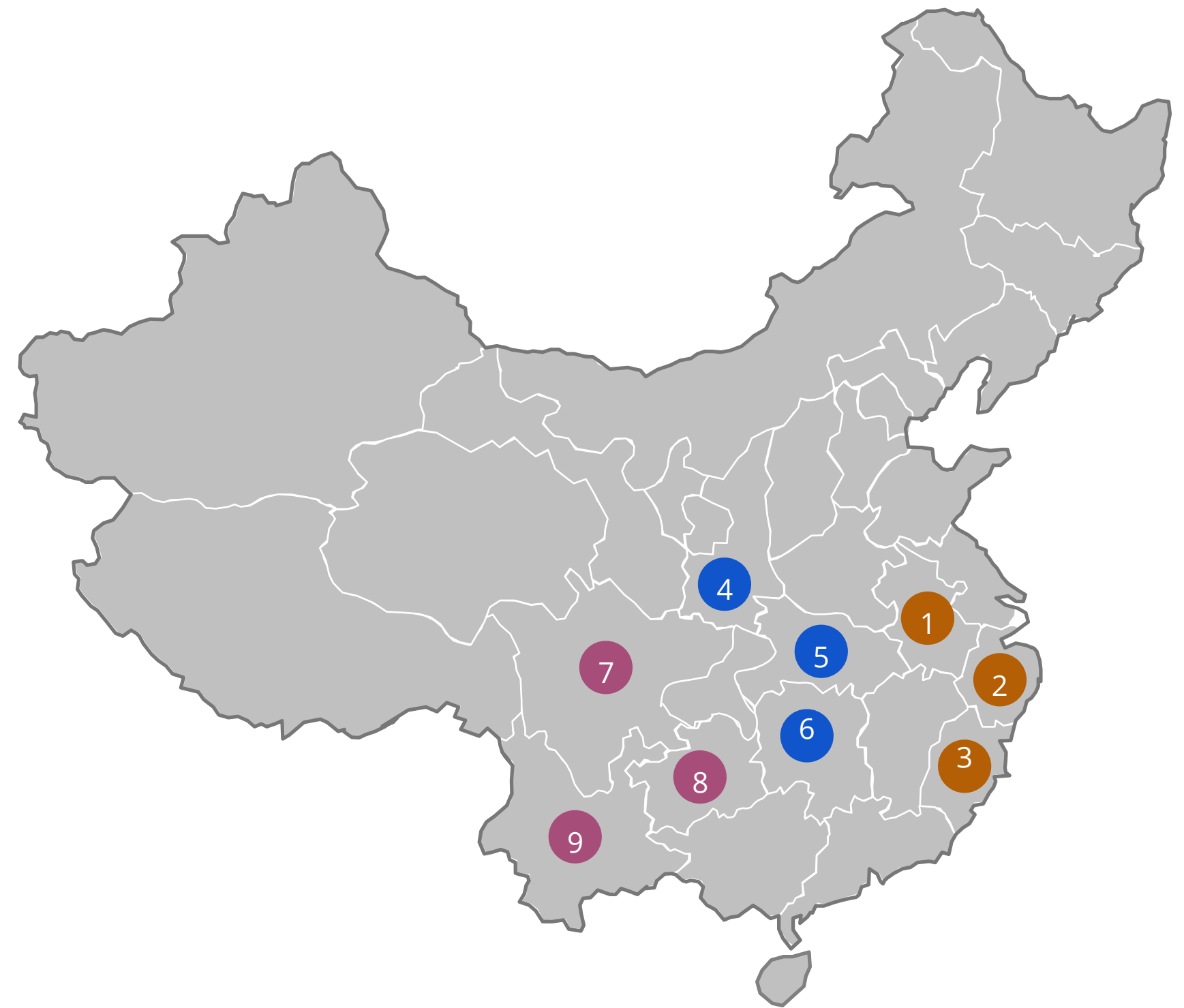
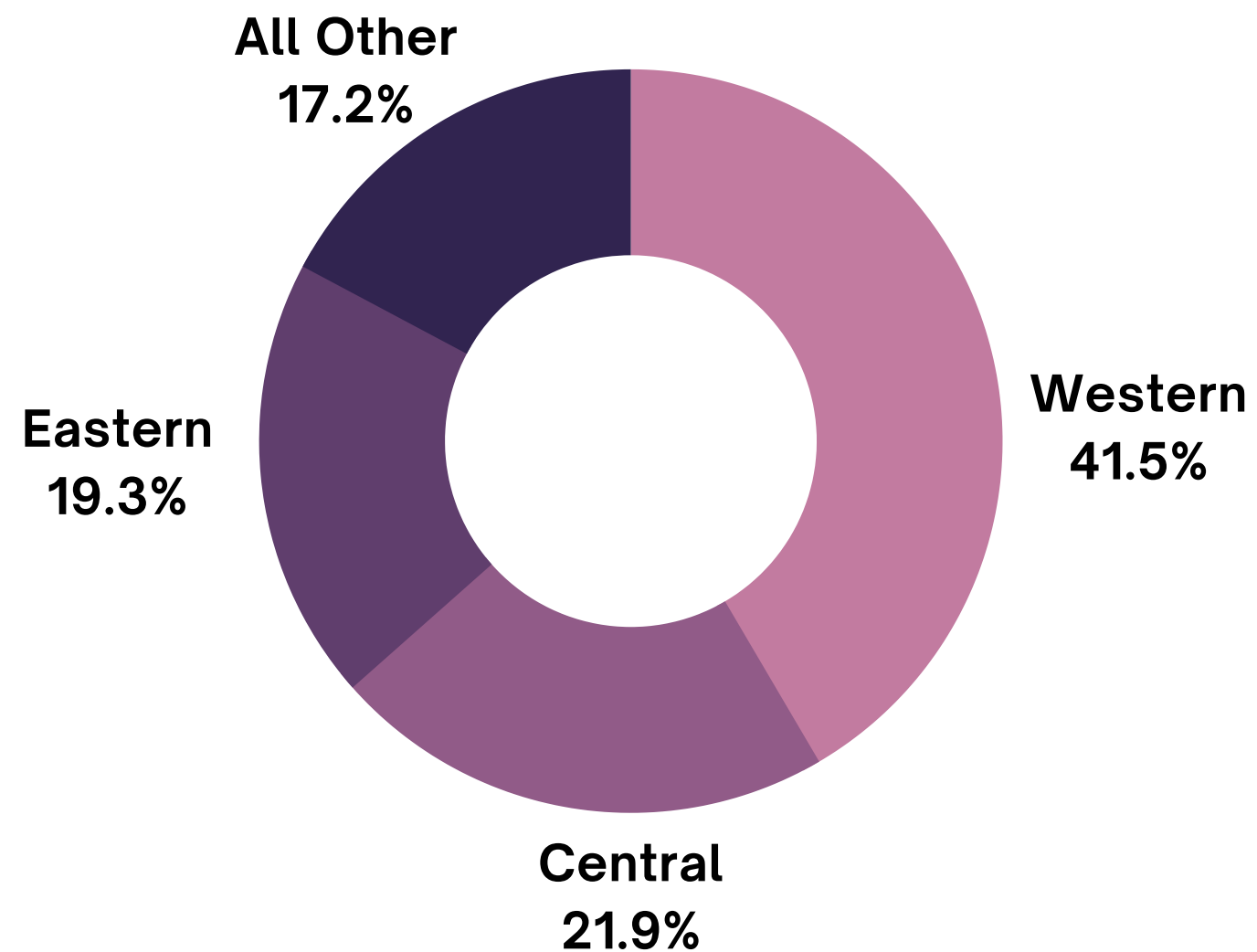

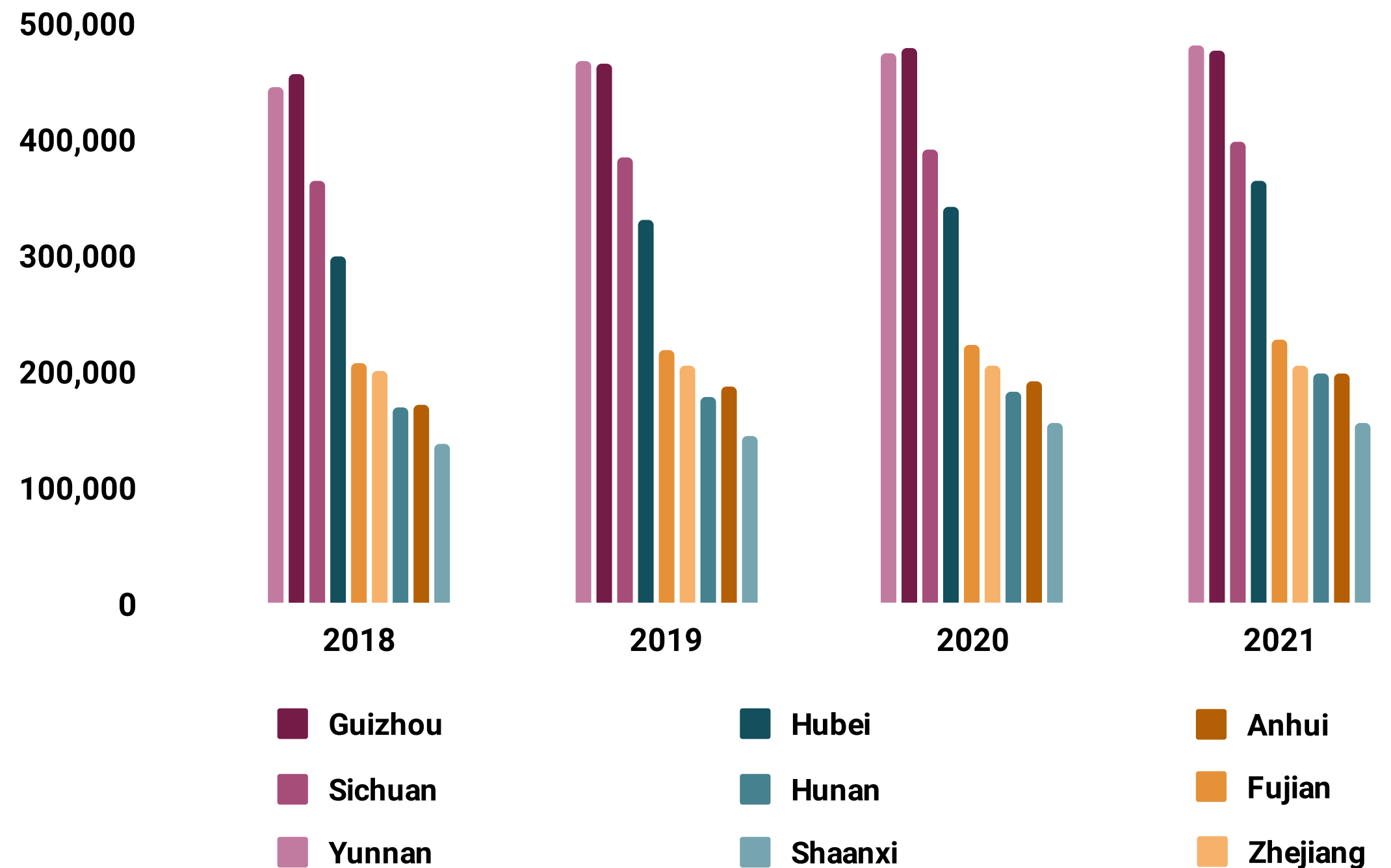

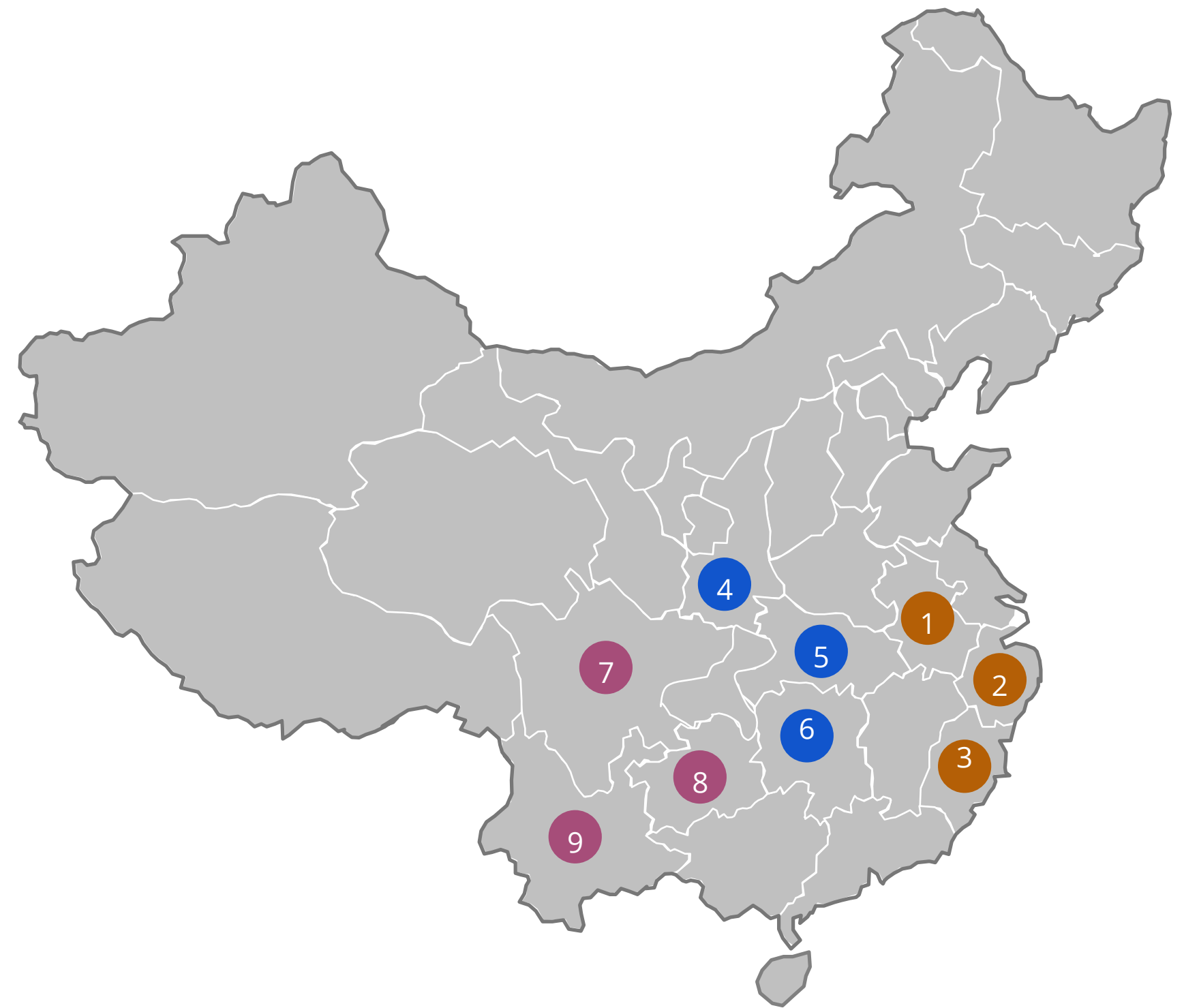
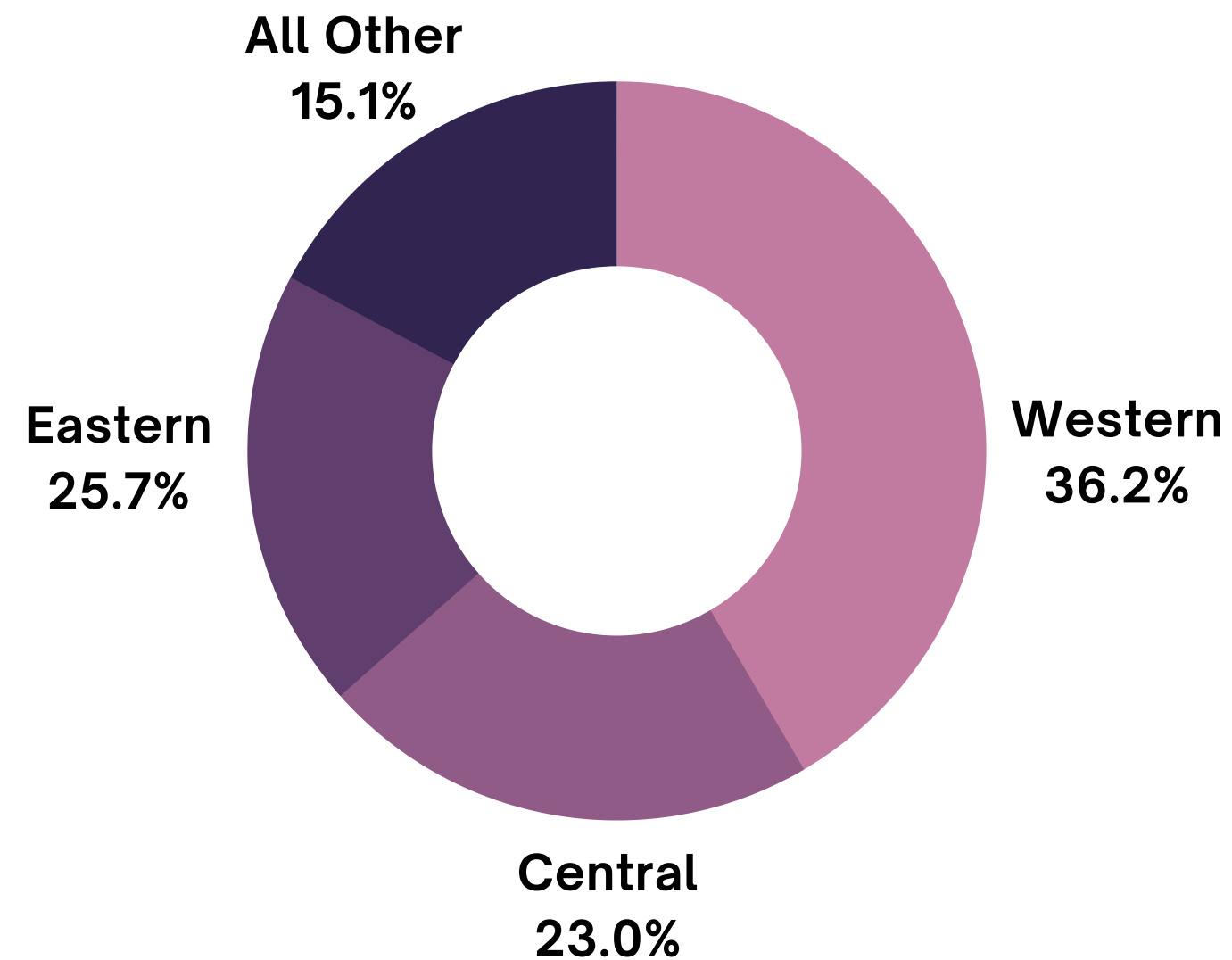

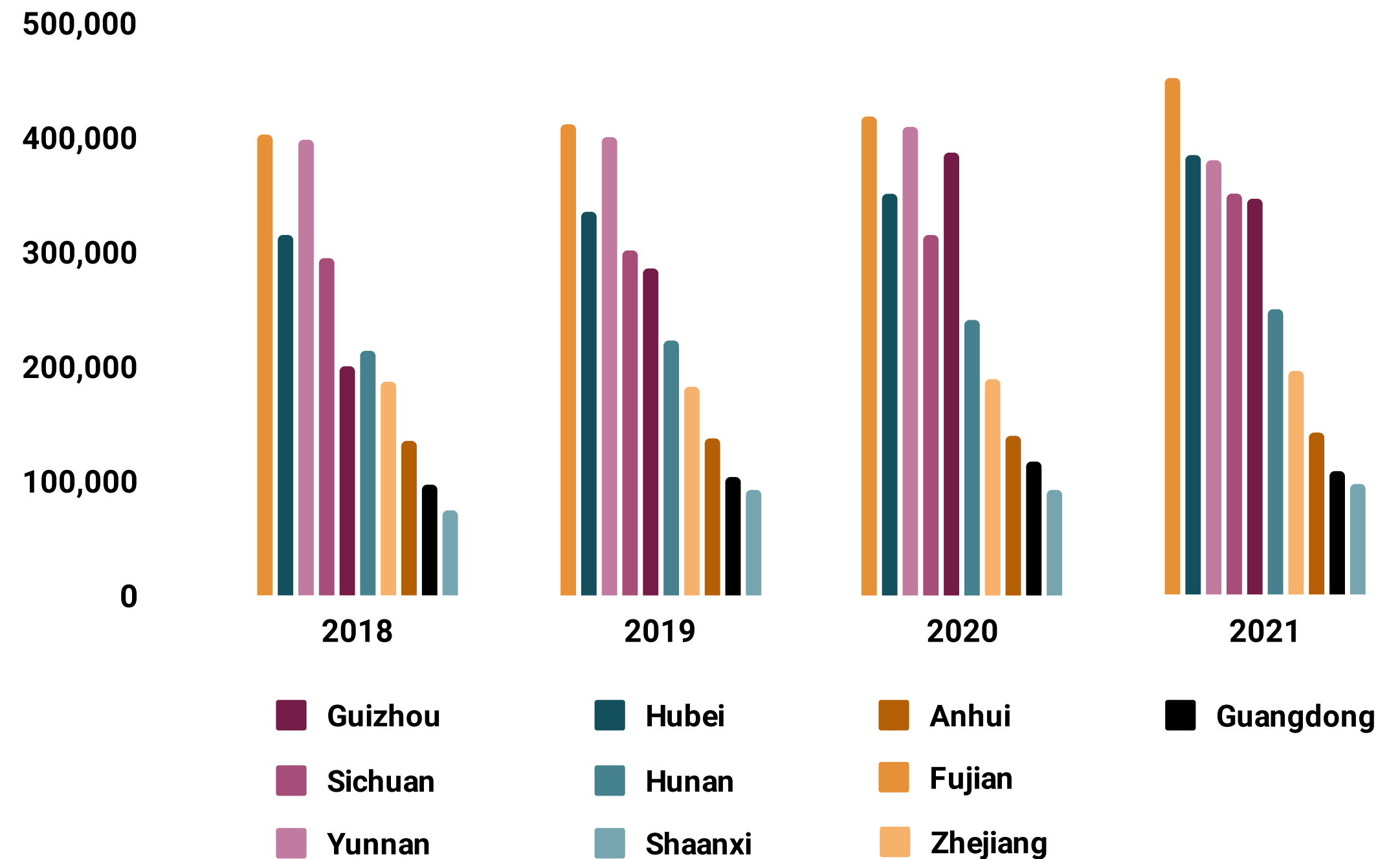

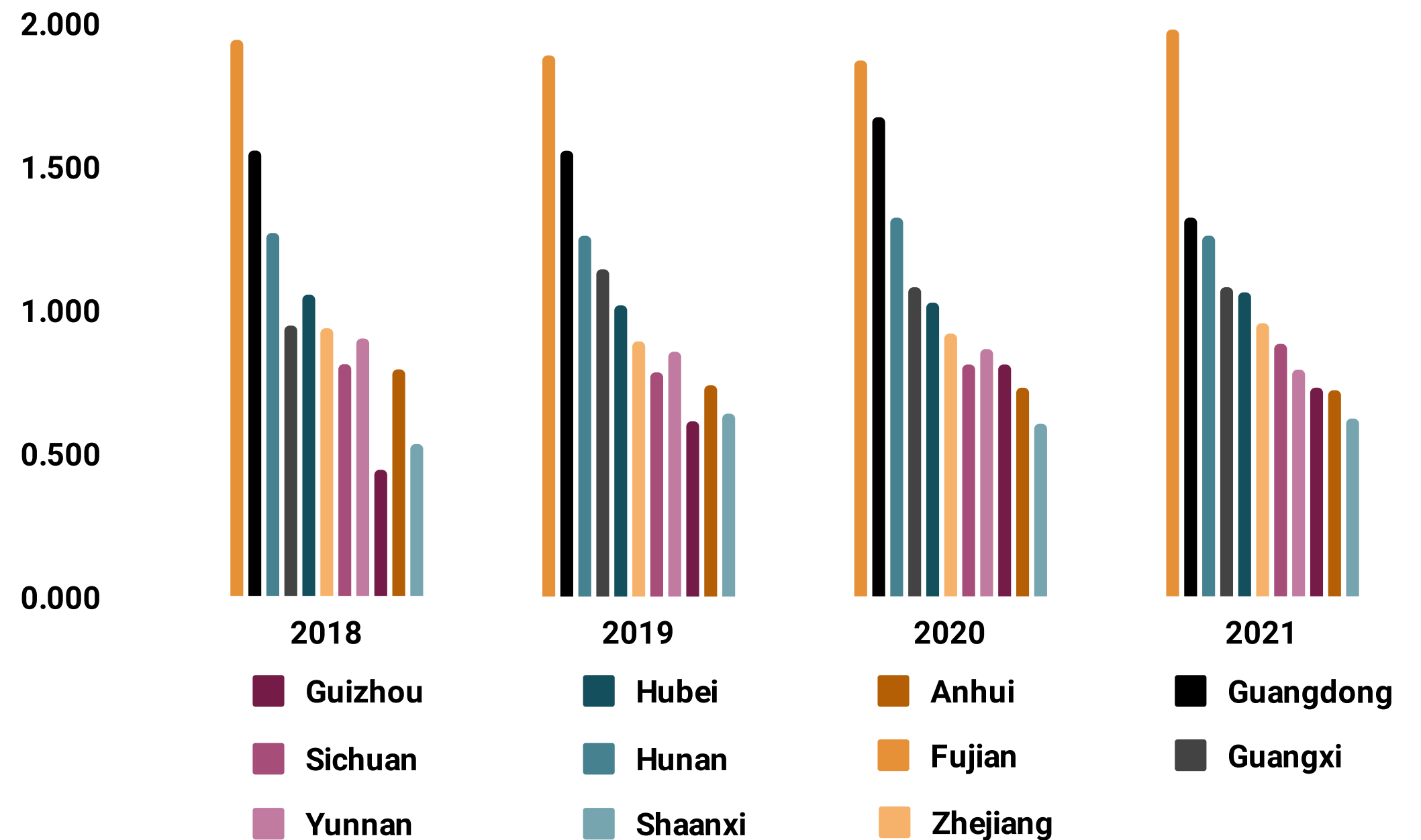


Yield: Tonnes per HA
